3 Ukraine2Canada Travel Fund

The Ukraine2Canada Travel Fund is a partnership between the Government of Canada and Miles4Migrants, The Shapiro Foundation, Air Canada and the Jewish Foundation of Greater Toronto.

Canadians and Canadian business can <u>donate travel</u> <u>points or cash to this fund</u>. These donations will be used to give free flights to Ukrainians and their family members who are in need of travel support.

In the initial phase, only 500 tickets were released; this initial phase is now closed. The goal is to fly at least 10,000 Ukrainians to Canadian communities in the coming months.
